NEA@50: One with ECs and MCOs for Sustainable Rural Development

Approved on 28 July 1969, the State policy of total electrification on an area coverage basis was declared through RA No. 6038 which provided for the organization of the National Electrification Administration (NEA) and the Electric Cooperatives (ECs). PD No. 269 converted NEA to a GOCC and was amended by PD No. 1645 and recently RA No. 10531. All amendatory laws are geared towards the promotion and continued implementation of the Rural Electrification for a sustainable rural development.

The partnership of NEA and the ECs in the last five decades proved its vital role in shaping the socio-economic landscape of the countryside that provided the rural folks-the EC Member-Consumer-Owners (MCOs) with the best opportunities for a better, more comfortable life through a reliable, safe, efficient and affordable electricity service.

2019 marks the Golden Anniversary of NEA and its commemoration, a series of activities is undertaken to make the year meaningful and memorable for NEA, together with its partner-ECs and the MCOs.
