The Emergency Preparedness Team shall be a part of the Health, Wellness, Welfare and Safety Committee with the following duties and responsibilities:

- 1. Monitor and ensure NEA's compliance to safety health standards and protocols;
- 2. Provide safety management and engage all employees in programs that ensure safety practices in the workplace;
- 3. Plan, implement and review the safety and health policies and practices based on approved procedures and requirements;
- 4. Act in an advisory capacity on all matters pertaining to health and safety for the guidance of the employer and the workers;
- 5. Investigate accidents, write incident reports, and make recommendations;
- 6. Coordinate all health and safety training programs for the employees and employer;
- 7. Conduct health and safety inspection as member of the team;
- Provide assistance to government agencies in the conduct of safety and health inspection, accident investigation or any other related programs;
- 9. Eliminate work hazards; and
- 10. Submit an Emergency Preparedness Plan and updated policy/ protocol as part of NEA's Environmental Management Program.

This supersedes Office Order No. 2023 - 112 dated May 02, 2024.

All expenses to be incurred in the performance of their duties shall be charged against proper funds of this office, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
