REQUEST FOR REFERENDUM ON THE CY 2024 PERFORMANCE EVALUATION SYSTEM (PES) REQUIREMENTS

Pursuant to Section 4(s) of the Presidential Decree (P.D.) No. 269, as amended; Section 5 of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 10531 or the *Powers, Functions and Privileges of the National Electrification Administration*, the National Electrification Administration (NEA) is authorized and empowered to exercise such powers and do such things as may be necessary to carry out the business and purposes for which the NEA was established, or which from time to time may be declared by the Board of Administrators as necessary, useful, incidental or auxiliary to accomplish such purposes; and Section 5 of P.D. No. 269, all of the powers of the NEA shall be vested in and exercised by the Board of Administrators;

WHEREAS, the Management, in its Memorandum dated 1 August 2023 earnestly requested for the referendum of the CY 2024 Performance Evaluation System (PES) requirements;

WHEREAS, the minutiae are stated hereunder:

I. Background

The Governance Commission for GOCCs (GCG) issued Memorandum Circular (M.C.) No. 2023-01, the Performance Evaluation System (PES) for the GOCC Sector, that provided the framework for setting the organizational targets. The achievements of such targets shall serve as basis for the following:

- a. Determining the grant of Performance-Based Bonus (PBB) and Performance-Based Incentives (PBI);
- Determining whether Appointive Directors are eligible for re-appointment;
- Ascertain whether a GOCC should be reorganized, merged, streamlined, abolished or privatized; and
- d. Determining whether a special audit of the GOCC is necessary

Accordingly, the following are the required PES documents for submission to GCG not later than the last working day of October:

- Strategy Map which includes the GOCC's Mission, Vision and Core Values (PES Form 1);
- Proposed Performance Scorecard PES Form 2 (Annual Performance Scorecard);
- 3. Measure Profile (PES Form 2a);
- 4. Briefer on the rationale of the CY 2024 targets; and
- Corporate Operating Budget (COB) for CY 2024 as submitted to DBM.

As one of the globally accepted corporate governance practices and in accordance with the requirements of the Corporate Governance Scorecard (CGS), the Board undertakes the annual review of the Strategy Map including the Vision and Mission as well as the corresponding strategies for its attainment.

Beginning 2017, the Board annually approved the Vision of NEA as "A dynamic and responsive NEA that is a vanguard of sustainable rural development in partnership with globally-competitive Electric Cooperatives and empowered Electricity Consumers" as well as its mandated mission, which is lifted from RA 10531. However, as discussed during the 2023 NEA Strategic Conference-Workshop, there is a need to revise the Vision to further align it with the direction of the new administration.

The existing Mandated Mission and Core Values were determined to still be responsive to the needs of the Agency.

The Performance Scorecard and Measure Profile translates the Strategic Objectives in the Strategy Map


