TO : ALL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVES (ECs)
SUBJECT : SITIO ELECTRIFICATION PROGRAM (SEP) IMPLEMENTATION

The present administration has been vigorously campaigning for the "Matuwid na Daan" as a measure in public service. In line with this, we are expected and required to uphold good governance and transparency in all government transactions. With the forthcoming 2013 National and Local elections, the ECs may not be spared from the influence, wittingly or unwittingly, of some politicians/local leaders at the expense of the cooperative.

The President in many fora had openly declared his recognition of the significance of the ECs, gaining his trust and confidence, thus the inclusion of the Sitio Electrification Program (SEP) as a major part of his administration's economic and development framework.

Accordingly, our member-consumers must be made aware, especially the recipients, that SEP is a key component of the Aquino administration's poverty alleviation program. Towards this end, it is seriously desired that the program should not be used to serve the interest, political or otherwise, of unscrupulous EC officials/employees and/or their relatives who are seeking elective posts in the 2013 elections. Consequently, those who may be the subject of complaints and those who shall be found to be taking advantage of the program shall be dealt with accordingly.

Let us therefore reciprocate the President's confidence in us by our full commitment towards the achievement of his aspirations in providing efficient and reliable power service to the Filipino nation with integrity and transparency.
