Interested eligible bidders may inspect the bidding documents and/or obtain a copy at the office of the BAC. Pre-bid Conference will be held on June 14, 2018 2:00PM at the TARELCO I Board Room also of the same address.

Sealed proposals must be received by the BAC at the TARELCO I office on June 28, 2018 not later than 9:00A.M. at which time and place the said proposal will be opened and read in the presence of Bidders or Bidders' representative who choose to attend. Late submission of sealed bid will not be considered or accepted.
