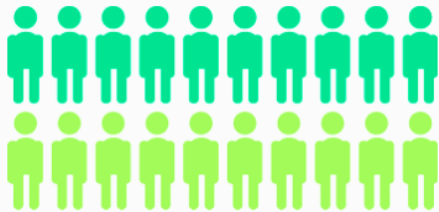

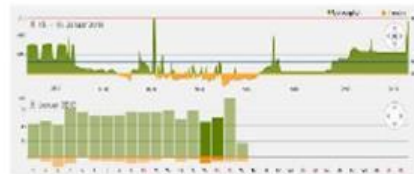

PAMILACAN ISLAND, BOHOL

Expanded Off-Grid Electrification

WeGen provided Daytime electricity from 4:00 PM to 12:00 MN



- They previously had only diesel-Powered electricity from 4:00PM to 12:00MN
- Over **330 families** are benefiting from expanded, clean energy.

For the first time, the schools and health center have electricity during the day, and fisher folk have more refrigeration options for their catch.



In a turnover ceremony held at the Pamilacan National High School, WeGen, a new company that began operating last 2016, unveiled a 39kWp solar photovoltaic (PV) and battery storage system that would provide energy to at least 300 households in the island. -Philstar.com/Jan Milo Severo
