Policy Framework

Republic Act No. 9136 (EPIRA)

- Efficiency, Transparency and Competition
- Effective Governance and Regulations
 - Consumer Empowerment and Protection



Competitive Selection Process (CSP)

- CSP is not new.
 - First mandated in off-grid areas through DC2004-01-001, issued on 24 Jan 2004, introduced Private Sector Participation (PSP) in Existing NPC-SPUG Areas.
- Complemented by the Regulator.
 - Issued ERC Resolution No. 11, Series of 2005, "Adopting the Guidelines for the Setting and Approval of Electricity Generation Rates and Subsidies for Missionary Electrification Areas."



Competitive Selection Process

- PSP in SPUG Areas (DC No. 2004-01-001)
 - Competitive process to be used to select one or more New Private Providers (NPPs) to supply power to area
 - DU options in managing competitive process—
 - Use a Transactions Advisor
 - NPC-SPUG assigns its PSA with the Distribution Utility (DU) to NPP through a competitive process
 - The DU manages competitive selection process by itself

Department Circular No. DC2015-06-0008

"Mandating All DUs to Undergo CSP in Securing PSAs"

Highlights:

- Signed on 11 June 2015 and published on 30 June 2015 at the Philippine Daily Inquirer and The Philippine Star.
- Will not apply to PSAs with tariff rates already approved and/or have been applied for approval by the ERC before the effectivity of the Circular.
- There shall be enforcement and compliance monitoring by the DOE, and with penalty provision through ERC.



Department Circular No. DC2015-06-0008

"Mandating All DUs to Undergo CSP in Securing PSAs"

Salient Features

- Requires all DUs to conduct CSP, through a Third Party duly recognized by the DOE and ERC. In the case for Electric Cooperatives, shall be recognized by the NEA;
- CSP shall conform with the following:
 - Aggregation of DUs un-contracted demand requirement;
 - Annual conduct of CSP; and
 - Uniform PSA Template on the terms and conditions to be issued by the ERC and DOE



Department Circular No. DC2015-06-0008

"Mandating All DUs to Undergo CSP in Securing PSAs"

Salient Features

- ERC and DOE to issue Implementing Guidelines (IG) within
 120 days from the effectivity of the Circular (i.e., 27 October 2015)
- IG shall contain specific details on the process of aggregation of un-contracted demand requirements of DUs and accreditation of Third Party authorized to conduct CSP
- ERC to issue supplemental guidelines and procedures on the design and execution of the CSP



SUBSEQUENT ISSUANCES BY DOE AND ERC ON CSP



JOINT DOE & ERC RESOLUTION NO.1 (2015)

"A Resolution Enjoining All Distribution Utilities to Conduct Competitive Selection Process (CSP) in the Procurement of Supply for Their Captive Market"



- Signed on 20 October 2015 and published on 07
 November 2015 at the Philippine Daily Inquirer and The Philippine Star
- DOE and ERC recognize that CSP in the procurement of PSAs by the DUs engenders transparency, enhances security of supply, and ensure stability of electricity prices to captive electricity end-users in the long-term
- ERC to issue the appropriate regulations to implement the CSP



ERC RESOLUTION NO.13 (2015)

"A Resolution Enjoining All Distribution Utilities to Conduct Competitive Selection Process (CSP) in the Procurement of Supply for Their Captive Market"



- Signed on 20 October 2015 and published on 06
 November 2015 at the Philippine Daily Inquirer
- Prescribes the following:
 - PSA shall be awarded to the winning Generation Company following a successful transparent and competitive selection process or by Direct Negotiation;
 - DU may adopt any accepted form of CSP;



- Direct Negotiation maybe made by the DU after at least two
 (2) failed CSPs:
 - DU did not receive any proposal;
 - Only one supplier submit proposal; and
 - Competitive proposal from prospective suppliers failed to meet the TOR requirements as determined by the DU's BAC.
- Will not apply to PSAs already filed with the ERC as of the effectivity of the Resolution



"A Resolution Clarifying the Effectivity of ERC Resolution No.13, series of 2015"



- Signed on 15 March 2016
- Effective 30 April 2016, all DUs shall conduct CSP for the supply of their Captive Market
- There should be at least two (2) qualified bids for the CSP to be considered as successful
- DUs shall adopt the Terms of Reference prescribed in Section
 2 of ERC Resolution No.13, series of 2015

- On PSAs with provisions on automatic renewal or extension of term:
 - PSAs approved by ERC or filed before the effectivity of Resolution No.1, may have one (1) automatic renewal or extension for a period not exceeding one (1) year from the end of their respective terms;
 - There will be no automatic renewal or extension of PSAs upon effectivity of Resolution No.1



Next Steps

- DOE and ERC to re-convene the CSP Technical Working Group to prepare the Supplemental Guidelines on CSP
- Conduct of public consultations
- Issuance of Supplemental Guidelines on CSP
