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INVITATION TO PRE-QUALIFY TO BID

The CAGAYAN II ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC. (CAGELCO II) is inviting all interested bidders to pre-qualify to bid for the supply and delivery of materials/equipment required for CAGELCO II Projects as specified through simple bidding procedures for current and future requirements of CAGELCO II with Approved Budget of the Contract (ABC) below PHP 2,000,000.00.

- I. **ELECTRICAL MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT** such as, line hardwares, compression connectors, insulators, wires & conductors, concrete poles(I-type), anchor logs , wood cross arms, wood poles, kilowatt hour meters, meter lock seal, distribution transformers(7620-240V, Conventional),current transformers, cut-out & fuselinks, housewiring materials, insulating oil, etc.
- II. **Lineman Tools & Equipment** such as hardhat, telescopic ladder, pole climber set, ratchet, bolt cutter, post belt, l-pads, shotgun stick, side cutting plier, etc.
- III. **Office Electronic Equipments** such as desktop and laptop computers, printers, LCD monitors, APC batteries, external drives, CCTVs, air conditioners, etc.
- IV. **Printing of forms (Job order)** such as official receipts, receiving reports, material charged tickets, change meter orders, meter repossession orders, transformer clearances, transformer repossession orders, travel orders, leave of absence, travel reports, etc.
- V. **Office supplies** such as logbook, bond papers, continuous forms, pens, envelops, folders, columnar books/pads, tapes, paper clips, staple wire, sign pen/refill, batteries, printer ink, printer ribbon, printer cartridge, etc.
- VI. **Vehicle maintenance requirements** such as tires engine/ lube oils, vehicle parts, etc.

Please submit the following to the BAC Chairman, Engr. Prosperido S. Ignacio, Jr.:

- a. DTI Business name Registration
- b. SEC registration certificate
- c. Valid and current Mayor's permit/municipal license
- d. Tax payer's identification number
- e. BIR Value Added Tax Registration
- f. Certification that the supplier/contractor is not black listed or banned from bidding by the government or any of its agencies and other corporations or electric cooperatives
- g. Compliance with EO #398
 - i. Proof of VAT payment for the past six months
- ii. Tax clearance from the BIR for the last two quarters
- h. On-going, completed or awarded contract not yet started within the relevant period specifying the following:
 - i. Name of the contract
 - ii. Date of contract
 - iii. Amount of contract and value of outstanding contracts
 - iv. Date of delivery
 - v. End-user's acceptance if completed

An accreditation fee of Five Thousand Pesos (non-refundable) is required for every company who wishes to be considered for accreditation.

Further, once accredited, the company must post a bond of Ten Thousand Pesos (Php 10,000.00), refundable upon updating of accreditation documents during the first quarter of each succeeding year. However, same may be forfeited depending on the performance of the company during the year end and shall be based on the contract with the cooperative.

Deadline for the submission of requirements shall be on October 31, 2017.

Accredited suppliers shall be informed of their accreditation with the cooperative to supply and delivery of materials and equipment.
