(ANTECO), thru its Procurement, Bids and Award Committee (PBAC), invites interested bidders/suppliers to bid for the **"Supply of Labor for Retirement and Construction of Cooperative's Distribution Line** affected by DPWH road widening project", in various location within ANTECO franchise area with **Approved Budget Cost (ABC) of Two Million Seven Hundred Thirty Four Thousand Two Hundred Seventy Two Pesos and 75 centavos (Php2,734,272.75)** which will be funded from government subsidies.
