- Request further to submit sealed bid/proposal and latest company profile in the prescribed format. Bid for one or two item(s) per schedule is not acceptable. Please submit BID BOND equivalent to two percent (2%) of the approved budget cost if it is cash or Manager's Check or if it is a surety bond, it must be equivalent to ten percent (5%) of the approved budget cost. Bid bond less than the required amount will be automatically disqualified. Bids/proposals submitted beyond the specified date and time will not be accepted.
