



INVITATION TO BID Simplified Bidding No. 18 Series of 2023

Pursuant to National Electrification Administration (NEA) Memorandum No. 2017-019, otherwise known as the "Revised Procurement Guidelines and Simplified Bidding Procedures for Electric Cooperatives IRR-RA10531 (2017)," the Isabela-I Electric Cooperative, Inc. Bidding will be conducted through simplified bidding procedures (sealed canvass) as specified in the Alternative Modes of Procurement in the NEA Memorandum 2017-019, otherwise known as the "Revised Procurement Guidelines and Simplified Bidding Procedures for Electric Cooperatives IRR-RA10531 (2017).

Bid proposals must be **VAT inclusive**, and the same must be submitted **personally or via courier** to the **BAC Secretariat at the address given below on or before 05 October 2023 until 10:00 AM. Bid proposals must be placed in a sealed envelope.** Template for the bid proposal is hereto attached for your reference.
4. Late bids shall not be accepted.
5. Bid Opening shall be conducted on **05 October 2023, 11: 00 A.M.**, at the BAC Office of ISELCO-I, Victoria, Alicia, Isabela.
