**SUBJECT : Ensuring Reliable Electric Power Supply During the 2010
Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Elections**

To ensure reliable power for all activities during the Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Elections on 25 October 2010, the ECs are strongly advised to undertake the following measures:

1. Conduct routine checkup of the distribution networks starting from the substation up to the end of the power line;
2. Determine inventory supply and make necessary procurement of critical materials;
3. Coordinate with Department of Education officials regarding the checking/inspection, and possible upgrading of wirings of polling centers and protective devices to avoid breakdown;
4. Organize skeletal force/personnel on a 24-hour basis as quick response team for any line or equipment breakdown;
5. Assign a substation tender, preferably with military/police escort, on a round-the-clock basis to ensure continuous power supply as well as to safeguard the facilities against possible sabotage;
6. Assign a roving team to check periodically the physical condition of the distribution assets;
7. Establish close coordination with local authorities in order to avert any untoward incident that may occur in the distribution system failure;
8. If possible maintain a back-up generator and adequate inventory of critical materials in areas serving as polling centers;

9. Report and/or coordinate all significant outages to our Engineering Department, either through e-mail at segubanj@yahoo.com or fax to 929-20-40.
10. Conduct an assessment of the overall power supply situation during the election period; and
11. Submit the overall report to NEA.

The General Manager shall be the primary official responsible in ensuring compliance by EC to all prescribed requirements pertaining to its electricity service during the 2010 Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Election.

Let us make this exercise a successful one.
