Pursuant to the Republic Act No. 11285, otherwise known as "Energy Efficiency and Conservation Act", all electric cooperatives (ECs) are enjoined to implement energy efficiency programs to manage energy consumption, and secure sufficient and stable power supply at the least possible cost in the country.

In terms of the demand and supply sides of energy management, guiding policies promulgated in the energy sector should be stringently observed which include, but not limited to, the following:

- 1. Timely conduct of the Competitive Selection Process (CSP) consistent with the Department of Energy (DOE) Department Circular No. DC2018-02-0003 as amended by DOE Department Circular No. DC2021-09-0030 and other pertinent issuances
- Adherence to the Green Energy Option Program (GEOP) as part of RA No. 9513 also known as the "Renewable Energy Act of 2008" and in compliance with DOE Department Circular No. DC2018-07-0019 and Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) Resolution No. 8, Series of 2021
- 3. Reduction of System Loss prescribed under ERC Resolution No. 20, Series of 2017
- 4. Rationalization of the Universal Charge for Missionary Electrification (UCME) in accordance with the DOE Department Circular No. DC2019-01-0001
- 5. Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) campaign among the endusers on energy saving practices and measures

Proper and effective implementation of these policies will manifest through sustainable power supply, lower energy rates, and improved overall system performance of the power industry.
