SUBJECT

PUTTING UP OF SIGNAGES TO ALL OBSTRUCTING

FACILITIES AFFECTED BY DPWH ROAD WIDENING

PROJECTS

It has been observed that there are EC-owned distribution facilities located within the widened roadway pending compensation by the Government pursuant to DOE-DPWH Joint Circular Nos. 1, 2 and 3.

With the implementation of the Department of Works and Public Highways road widening projects, a number of affected electric distribution poles of the Electric Cooperatives (ECs) have remained within the road right-of-way posing safety risk to commuters and road users.

With the pendency of the process of compensation in the relocation of affected distribution poles, the ECs are directed to put up road safety signages on these obstructing poles to minimized or prevent risk to road users.

The ECs shall install safety signages, reflectorized stickers, or reflective paint clearly visible under headlight illumination.

The signages shall be installed at a minimum height of one (1) meter, and should be at least 450mm x 450 mm.
