
TO : ALL ECs affected by Tropical Cyclone "ODETTE"

SUBJECT : Affected ECs to Apply for CSP Certificate of Exemption (COE)
for the Procurement of Emergency Power Supply

This is in line with the recent Tropical Cyclone "ODETTE" that devastated the large part of the Visayas and Mindanao areas on 16 December 2021, thus, extensively damaged the power system on the ECs' franchise areas, in particular.

In view thereof, affected ECs are therefore advised to apply for a Certificate of Exemption (COE) for the CSP in the Procurement of Emergency Power Supply, as applicable, in accordance with the Department of Energy (DOE) DC2018-02-0003, as contained in Section 2.2.2 and Section 2.2.1.2 of DOE DC2021-09-0030, to mitigate the possible power shortage and to ensure the continuous supply of power.
