Therefore, we suggest technology should be limited to Diesel Generator.	It cannot be limited to Diesel as it is required in the Department of Energy (DOE)'s Renewable Portfolio Standards (RPS) Rules to mix the source of power requirement and include RE for at least one percent (1%) in offgrid areas. The bidding is open for all technologies, subject for evaluation and must be determined as the lowest calculated responsive bid.
	Kindly provide the basis of 0.4MW RE component with adequate BESS?	It is based on the DOE template in reference to RPS Rules for Off-Grid which provides the capacity requirement for certain year.
	If we include this RE component, it may greatly affect the CRF of the Bidder hence increasing the Bid Price. To make bidding more competitive, hence we suggest to delete the REcomponent.	The computation of CRF for the Open Technology and RE is different. There will be different evaluations. And due to RPS Rules, the RE will not be deleted. The evaluation of the bidding price will be first done for open technology and after that, it will be merged with the RE price. The final figure will be a blended rate of both technologies - open tech and RE.

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Page 32. Delivery Voltage	Why is the Delivery Voltage at 4.16kV considering that the Main Grid voltage of Semirara is 34.5kV?	ANTECO only has 4.16 kV line and not 34.5kV.
Page 33. Prompt Payment Discount	Can ANTECO provide the standard prompt payment discount rate that bidders can offer to level the field for all Bidders?	Other than the Prompt Payment Discount, the Bidder is allowed to offer other form of discount which will be taken into consideration in the template.
Page 34. Reservation Clause	Parties should be given ample opportunity to negotiate before any planned reduction due to changes in the ANTECO franchise coverage.	The island is a captive market and is projected to increase rather than decrease with no possible contestable customer for the contract duration.

There will be no financial workshop to be conducted since the template to be provided is easy to use and any questions that the Bidders want to ask the BAC or TWG, they shall submit the list of questions thru a letter and email it to the BAC's email address.
